



In order to help you make the best planting choices for your landscape project, please complete this form before contacting us or coming in to purchase plants.

1. Measurements including placement of windows, doors, walkways, driveway, existing trees and if trees cast shade on part of the yard (drawings and pictures work best).

2. Approximate number of hours of direct sunlight does this area receive and at what time of the day (morning or afternoon)?

3. What other plants have you grown in this location before, and how did they grow there?

4. What is the soil condition in this area? Sandy, clay, rocky, well draining, standing water?
It's best to bring us a sample in a baggie.

5. How much time do you want to spend on plant maintenance? i.e. – you like to putter in the yard a lot, too busy...as little time as possible, or somewhere in between.

6. Are you trying to accomplish something other than beauty? i.e. – privacy or sound barrier, edible fruits, shade, drainage, fall color, keep the neighbor's dog out, etc.

7. Do you have color preferences?

8. Do you have any animals that roam the yard? Dogs, cats, deer, rabbits, mice?
Some plants are more inviting for them to nibble on than others.
